

HOME MAINTENANCE TIPS FOR WINTER

☐ Keep humidity levels lower as the temperature drops.
☐ Keep window treatments open as much as possible.
☐ Clean or replace furnace filter as needed.
☐ Check hot water heater for mineral build up.
☐ Clean range hood filter.
☐ Check smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors.
☐ Occasionally open a couple of windows for about 10 minutes to help air quality and prevent moisture build up.
☐ Clean faucet aerators.
☐ Pour water in floor drains to maintain the trap's water barrier.
☐ Check outside vents (dryers, bath exhaust fans, furnaces, etc.) to make sure they are working properly and free of frost, snow, and debris.
☐ With an older home that is not well insulated, a professional should remove the snow from the roof to prevent shingle damage and ice dams from forming.
☐ Avoid walking or driving on the lawn without snow cover.
